Cook-off Rules

Food entries are best if BBQ-friendly. All entrants must bring self-contained cooking units. If not BBQ's, be sure to provide your own generators, water supplies, etc. The Mission is unable to assist in generating additional power for this event.

Dishes prepared must feed fifty (50) [If you are able to feed more, we welcome the extra!] ... *chicken, chili, tri-tip, ribs, rice, potatoes, corn-on-the-cob, ... whatever!*

There is no entry fee and all food will be offered free to event participants and guests

All participants must acquire (or already have) a food permit and must provide a copy of the permit to the FRM event coordinator prior to the entry deadline.

You need not be experienced to enter. In fact, our Food Services Department professionals prefer to compete against novices!

All food entries should be ready for judging and give-away by 4:00 PM (The Mission will provide free hotdogs and drinks during the tour times to prevent starving participants from storming your booths early)

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES on the premises, even if used as an ingredient in a recipe.
